### **Use Of Entertainment Union Contracts**

**WHEREAS**, the member unions of the AFL-CIO, and the AFL-CIO itself require union accommodations for all official gatherings; and

**WHEREAS**, all unions' building repair and renovations are undertaken by union contractors; and

**WHEREAS**, every union's printed material is generated by union printers; and

**WHEREAS**, union members in their personal lives consider union-made goods and services when they make their buying decisions; now therefore be it

**RESOLVED** that the OR AFL-CIO will work with affiliates to create a list of affiliate entertainment unions for affiliates to contact when seeking workers to fulfill a project; and be in further

**RESOLVED** that unions will consult with their entertainment union affiliates before contracting out work; and be it further

**RESOLVED** that the OR AFL-CIO will urge affiliates to make every best effort to use workers that work under the appropriate entertainment union contract when contracted out; and now be it finally

**RESOLVED** that writers, actors, announcers, musicians, dancers, singers, and other performers whose voices or likenesses are recorded or transmitted for use in Radio, Television, the Internet, other media outlets, or non-broadcast/educational projects work under the appropriate union contract; and that actors, musicians, dancers, singers, and other performers hired for convention functions, rallies, union parties, celebrations, and theatrical performances work under the appropriate union contract; and that stagehands, A/V workers, lighting, sound and staging as well as motion picture technicians, and content creators working on either live performances or recordings will work under the appropriate union contract.
